RE: PUBLIC SAFETY MINISTER REFUSES TO RESPOND TO MY CONCERNS

Please find attached a copy of a letter I sent to the Minister of Public Safety dated April 4, 2012. I sent an original to Minister Toews' Parliament Hill office and to his Departmental headquarters. I also sent a copy to all Conservative MP's and Senators by e-mail, including your own office. To date I have received neither an acknowledgement nor a reply from anyone in your government.

On March 1st I asked my own Member of Parliament, Blake Richards, to try and get an answer from the Minister's officer but he hasn't had any success either. I've attached a recent news clipping from the Calgary Herald and Edmonton Journal that demonstrates just how ridiculous it is for the government to have such costly, ineffective public safety priorities.

I hope you can put some pressure on Minister Toews to respond directly to the concerns I raised in this letter. These issues are important, not just for me, but for the entire firearms community.
