Reference is being made to 2,210 complaints filed with the RCMP by High River residents for \$2.5 million dollars in damages caused by the RCMP's unnecessary and unwarranted entries and unwarranted searches of and seizures from High River homes following the 2013 flood.

Please include copies of any records discussed in these meetings including: briefing notes, presentations, reports, government commissioned polls, correspondence, consequences for High River residents if the results of the above polls are right, corrective action necessary to rebuild trust in the RCMP among High River residents; and, finally, copies any handwritten notes taken at those meetings by the persons in attendance.
