NFA member since 1995.

I have been active in promoting shooting sports and working within Canadian law to change Federal firearms legislation since 1977 when the first gateway (read barrier) to firearms acquisition was passed by the Trudeau government when Ron Basford was minister of Justice.

I was president of Zone 6 Alberta Fish And Game Association clubs (North West Alberta) from 1982 to 1986.

I was President of the Responsible Firearms Owners of Alberta 2004 to 2013. I resigned when I was elected Alberta NFA director. As RFOA Vice president, prior to 2004 I attended many meetings with Federal M.P.s and public safety representatives attempting to convince them to take the non violent, non victim, administrative Firearms act Infractions out of the criminal code of Canada

I attended RFOA meetings as an RFOA member and as CNFA representative until the RFOA (Canada's oldest and last provincial firearms organization) dissolved in 2018.

I spend between 30 and 60 hours a week on firearms rights related activism and promotion and have done so since Feb 14, 1994. The date C68(1995) was tabled in Parliament.

My goal is to work within the law to change the Firearms act and convince the party in power to rescind criminal code penalties for the non associated with administrative Firearms Act infractions with no victim.
